
## **Meridian Arts & Culture Center**

Leasing and Investment Opportunity



**Vision**: An economically and environmentally sustainable center for Arts and Culture

<u>Mission</u>: Create signature properties in Meridian Township that are LEED certified and affordable for artisans to operate in a live/work/teach/market environment. Offer broad educational opportunities and apprenticeships, innovative nontraditional arts, and space for performance art. Adopt an inclusive, multi-discipline approach to enhance the quality of life in the Township and greater Lansing area by encouraging the creartist in all of us. Schooling in the *Fun Arts* as well as Fine Arts should be included.

<u>Immediate Goal</u>: Acquire and develop the property currently occupied by Travelers Club Restaurant, White Bros. Music and the historic Dr. James Smiley house. If this site is not used, other locations will be evaluated. Preliminary plans are under consideration in the Township planning office and call for the creation of a \$10 million mixed-use development with 25 housing units on the upper floors and commercial uses on the ground floor.

Included in the plans are a Brewpub, a Coffee Shop and a full service Restaurant with parking levels above and below ground level. Other possibilities may include a teaching kitchen, dance studio, woodworking studio, musical instrument atelier, glass blowing, video or film production, a recording studio, DIY brewing, private tutoring, conference space, or whatever creative minds can imagine.

To move the project forward, prospective tenants are being sought and a coalition of partners organized to raise the initial \$1.2 million dollars needed to acquire the property and proceed with the development. A nonprofit entity, an LLC, or possibly both will be formed for the best tax advantages and grant opportunities. The minimum suggested investment pledge is \$5,000 in monetary exchange or in-kind professional services such as legal, architectural or site development. Construction will not begin until the project site plan is approved by the Township Board, tenants are found and financing is in place.
